

Minutes to Light Rail

The **Graham Street Retail Center's** location is what the City of Seattle classifies as a Frequent Transit Corridor. This term is used to describe interconnected network of corridors with transit services operating at frequent and/or short intervals throughout the day, into the evening, and every day of the week.

The **Graham Street Retail Center** is almost equidistant between the Othello Transit Station and the Columbia City Transit Station. According to the City of Seattle, to get to either Transit Station from the retail center, each transit station is approximately 7-15 minutes away, depending upon if you walk or take the bus.

The Seattle Link Light Rail system is located ight in front of the shopping complex, thereby increasing frontage exposure. Depending upon the potential business usage for the property, this frontage exposure is a high visibility, value asset to any business choosing to lease here.

Demographics


The Martin Luther King Jr Way South area of Seattle, Washington is among the most culturally and economically diverse neighborhoods in the Pacific Northwest. The neighborhood's population is 34,241, with Asians making up the largest group (with Filipinos the largest within the Asian population of the Valley). However, there remains a large African American population, as well as those Americans of European descent.

Its zip code is 98118, which also includes the neighborhood directly east of Rainier Valley of Seward Park. Beacon Hill to the west is largely 98108. Rainier Valley's racial breakdown is as follows: 20.9% Caucasian, 32% African American, 34.1% Asian, 1% Native American, 1.6% Pacific Islander, 6.5% Mixed Race, and 3.4% from other races. Hispanic or Latino of any race were 7.2% of the population.
